Pakistan Museum of Natural History intends to hire the services of a reputable Architecture/Consultant Engineering Firm (registered with tax departments of Federal and Provincial governments in accordance with the applicable laws) to undertake all necessary assignments for conducting feasibility study for the completion of Pakistan Museum of Natural History building at Islamabad.

Detailed Request for Proposal (RFP), evaluation criteria and other related information for the purpose can be purchased at a cost of Rs.500/- from the address given below.

“Single Stage Two Envelop Procedure” will be used for open competitive bidding. The interested Architecture/Consultant Engineering Firms will submit their sealed bids comprising single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelope shall contain separately the “financial” and “technical” proposals which will be clearly mentioned in bold and legible letters on respective envelop to avoid any confusion.

RFP found not in accordance to the terms and conditions specified in the documents will be rejected forthwith. Incomplete tenders will be rejected straight away.

Sealed documents shall be submitted on or before 30th Oct, 2017 at 11:00 am. At the first stage, only technical proposals shall be opened on the same day at 11:30 am in the presence of representatives of the participating firms/consultants. The competent authority of Pakistan Science Foundation may reject any or all bids / proposals at any time prior to acceptance of the bids/proposals as provided under rule-33 of PPRA Rules-2004.
